Martin Schlageter is senior advisor to Los Angeles City Council President Marqueece Harris-Dawson, who represents the Eighth Council District.

With 20 years in non-profit organizations and more than a decade in public service, Martin has deep experience in public policy, governance, and sustainability. Before joining Council District 8, Martin was Special Assistant to the General Manager of [Metropolitan Water District of Southern California](#), a cooperative of 26 public agencies providing water to 19 million Southern Californians.

Martin created and led the external relations program for [StreetsLA](#) in the City of LA Department of Public Works, which is responsible for the upkeep of the City's streets, sidewalks, and street trees. He served as policy director for LA City Council District 14, helping shape policy and programs on a range of issues, including the City's first Comprehensive Homelessness Strategy and the \$1.2 billion bond measure HHH.

As an advocate with [Coalition for Clean Air](#), [Sierra Club](#) and [Friends of the Los Angeles River](#), Martin built a successful track record of environmental protection and collaborative policy making at the state, regional and local levels.
