

HOUSING COMMITTEE REPORT relative to rental assistance programs available to residents living in Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA) owned or administered properties.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Rodriguez – McOsker):

DIRECT the Housing Department, in coordination with HACLA and any other relevant departments or agencies, to report on all rental assistance programs currently available to residents living in HACLA owned or HACLA administered properties, including those funded or supported through Measure ULA.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

Summary:

On September 8, 2026, your Housing Committee considered a March 3, 2026 Motion (Rodriguez – McOsker) relative to rental assistance programs available to residents living in HACLA owned or administered properties. According to the Motion, many of the City's most vulnerable residents live in properties owned or administered by HACLA. Ensuring continuity of housing stability for these households aligns directly with the voter-approved intent of Measure ULA to prevent homelessness and protect tenants at risk. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Motion recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
