Sergeant Adrian Carrillo was a lifelong resident of Arleta and a proud graduate of Arleta High School. While still a senior in high school, he was elected to serve on the Arleta Neighborhood Council as a Youth Representative, where he earned widespread respect for his dedication to the community. During his tenure, he actively participated in neighborhood cleanups, charitable events, and other service efforts that reflected his deep commitment to improving the lives of those around him. Following his service on the Neighborhood Council, Sergeant Carrillo answered the call to serve his country by enlisting in the United States Marine Corps. Even while serving in the military, he remained closely connected to his family, friends, neighbors, and the Arleta community he loved.

Tragically, Sergeant Carrillo passed away unexpectedly in an accident on Friday, December 12, 2025. His life was marked by service to his country, to his family, and to his community. The intersection of Terra Bella Street and Woodman Avenue, located within the heart of the community he called home, serves as an appropriate and meaningful location to honor his legacy and that of those who served our country.

The act of honoring our veterans is essential, serving as a powerful demonstration of gratitude for the profound sacrifices made in defense of our nation and its freedoms. By recognizing their service, we acknowledge the dedication, courage, and commitment they displayed, often placing the needs of their country above their own. 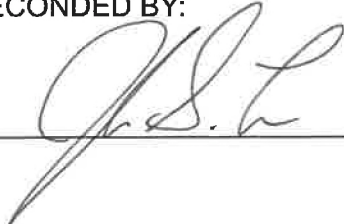
