GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS

The City has taken numerous recent actions to expand existing green spaces and parks and to identify locations for the development of new parks in Council District 10. It is crucial for the City to develop more parks, as these green spaces are known to improve public health and provide space for local communities to gather.

Currently, the lot at 4600 St. Elmo Drive is undeveloped and long been visually blighted. This location could be developed into a future park to provide residents with much-needed green space. In order to create more park and green space in Council District 10, the Department of Recreation and Parks should explore the development of a park at this location at the intersection of St. Elmo Drive and Vineyard Avenue.

I THEREFORE MOVE that Council instruct the Department of Recreation and Parks, with the assistance of the Bureau of Engineering, Bureau of Street Services, Department of Transportation, and Department of General Services, to begin the process of acquiring the property at 4600 St Elmo Drive in Council District 10 for the development of a park at this location.
