The Heritage Square Museum (Museum) located at ~~3800 Homer Street~~ Los Angeles, CA 90031 in Council District 1 explores the settlement and development of Southern California during its first 100 years of statehood through historic restoration and preservation. There are eight historic structures located at the Museum that are on City parkland.

The Museum would like to develop a comprehensive master plan for the site to enhance visitor experience, accessibility, and site connectivity for pedestrians, cyclists and users of mobility devices from the Heritage Square/Arroyo Metro A line station (Master Plan). The Master Plan will focus on accessibility to the Museum from the Pasadena Avenue entrance. Additionally, the development of a Master Plan will allow the City and Museum to identify opportunities to create more accessible and safe walking paths throughout the site.

The Master Plan is intended to produce key conceptual engineering plans, identify potential phases for implementing the project, and outline funding estimates for various aspects of the plan. The Master Plan should also align with the City's Park Needs Assessment, which includes guidelines on community engagement, site planning, and the park classification system. The Museum has identified \$50,000 to be used towards the development of a Master Plan.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council AUTHORIZE the Bureau of Engineering (BOE) to accept the donation of \$50,000 from the Heritage Square Museum to be used to develop a Master Plan that outlines a phased approach to install various improvements at the Heritage Square Museum, including design upgrades to the Pasadena Ave gate entrance of the museum to enhance connectivity to the Metro station, access ramp installations, and a special event parking plan and to deposit these funds into the Bureau of Engineering Fund No. 100, Department 78, Appropriation Account 001010 (Salaries General).

I FURTHER MOVE that the Council INSTRUCT the BOE, with the assistance of the Department of Recreation and Parks, to incorporate the City's Park Needs Assessment in the development of the Master Plan, including any community engagement, site planning, and park classification system guidelines.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Council AUTHORIZE BOE, with the assistance of any other necessary departments, to execute any required agreements to accept the donation from the Heritage Square Museum and effectuate the intent of this motion, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
