MOTION

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority's (Metro) Open Streets initiatives provide funding to temporarily close streets to automobile traffic and open them to cyclists, pedestrians, and other modes of non-motorized transportation of all ages and abilities. Events, such as CicLAvia, provide opportunities to experience public transportation, walking, and biking, potentially for the first time. Additionally, CicLAvia events are an effective way to boost activity for local restaurants, retail, and other small businesses.

The P.I.C.O. Neighborhood Council (PICO NC) encompasses portions of Council District 5 and Council District 10 and includes several park-poor communities. A CicLAvia event could provide much-needed recreational space, allow residents unique, non-vehicular experiences, and showcase the accessibility of existing and upcoming Metro stations in the area.

WE THEREFORE MOVE that the Council direct the Department of Transportation to submit an application during the next funding cycle of the Metro Open Streets Grant Program for a CicLAvia event to take place within the footprint of the PICO NC and within the following boundaries;

- o Pico Boulevard from La Cienega Boulevard to La Brea Avenue;
- o Fairfax Avenue from Pico Boulevard to San Vicente Boulevard; and
- o San Vicente Boulevard from Fairfax Avenue to La Brea Avenue; and

WE FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Transportation report with a timeline and implementation plan following submittal of the application.
