

ORDINANCE NO. _____

An ordinance approving Resolution No. 026 188 of the Board of Water and Power Commissioners authorizing the sale of City of Los Angeles property to the Bishop Paiute Tribe.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. It is found and determined that certain real property (Property) described in this ordinance, owned by the City of Los Angeles and under the management and control of the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP), should be sold to the Bishop Paiute Tribe.

Sec. 2. The Property is further described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The sale will be:

SUBJECT TO all outstanding taxes and assessments, if any.

SUBJECT TO any and all agreements, covenants, conditions, restrictions, easements, reservations, rights and rights-of-way of record, and other matters of record.

SUBJECT TO any rights-of-way which may be apparent if a visual inspection is made of said real property.

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING TO the City of Los Angeles all water and water rights, whether surface, subsurface, or of any other kind, and all water and water rights appurtenant or in anywise incident to the real property herein described, or used thereon or in connection therewith, together with the right to develop, take, transport, control, regulate, and use all such water; and reserving unto the City of Los Angeles all oil, gas, petroleum, or other mineral or hydrocarbon substances in and under said land, without the right to enter upon the surface of said land for such use.

Sec. 3. The Board of Water and Power Commissioners (Board) has adopted a resolution approving the sale of the Property to the Bishop Paiute Tribe, and is requesting the City Council to approve and authorize, by ordinance, the execution, acknowledgment, and delivery of an Agreement for Purchase and Sale of Real Property and Escrow Instructions (Agreement), and instruments, in writing, on behalf of the City of Los Angeles, as provided in Section 675(d)(2) of the Los Angeles Charter, in order to complete this transaction.


Sec. 4. The sale of the Property to the Bishop Paiute Tribe is hereby approved, authorized and ordered. The President or Vice President of the Board, or the General Manager of LADWP, or such person as the General Manager shall designate in writing, and the Secretary, Assistant Secretary, or the Acting Secretary of the Board, are hereby authorized and directed to execute, in the name of the City of Los Angeles, the Agreement, and instruments, in writing, approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, conveying said Property to the Bishop Paiute Tribe, and to perform all other actions necessary to complete these transactions.

Sec. 5. This ordinance shall be effective upon its publication as provided in Section 252(j) of the Los Angeles Charter.

Sec. 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
