

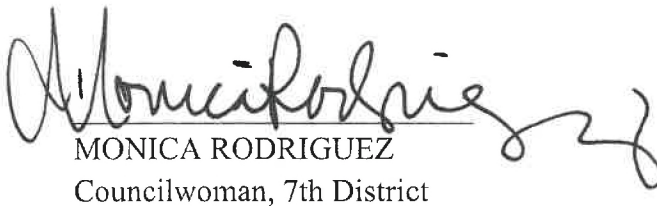
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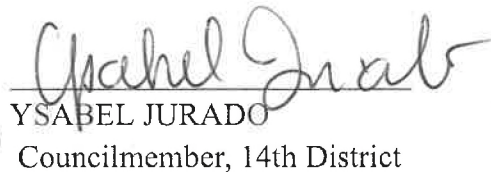
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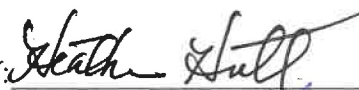
I MOVE that the matter of the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee Report relative to a communication from the Chief Legislative Analyst and the Charter Reform Commission with recommendations for amendments to the City Charter, Item No. 67 on today's Council Agenda, (CF 26-0489) BE AMENDED to ADOPT the following in lieu of the Report Recommendation No. 6 with the changes indicated below:

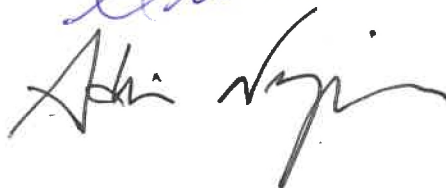
6. Request the City Attorney to prepare and present the documents necessary to amend Charter Section 593 related to the Charter-mandated minimum allocation for the Department of Recreation and Parks, as follows (CRC 4):
 - Increase the RAP's budget allocation to ~~0.0485%~~ **0.0650%** of assessed property value;
 - Phase the percentage increase to the RAP's budget **allocation** over a period of ~~four~~ **ten years in equal increments each year**;
 - Allow suspension of up to 30 percent of Charter-mandated funds if City declares a fiscal emergency;
 - **The suspension of up to 30 percent of Charter-mandated funds if the City declares a fiscal emergency, provided that any such suspension shall not decrease RAP's charter mandated funds below 0.0325% of assessed property value**
