

BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to legal options available to the City of Los Angeles regarding a pathway forward on homelessness governance and short-term strategic actions, including any potential claims, defenses, and strategies to protect the City's interests.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (McOsker - Jurado):

REQUEST the City Attorney to explore and report to Council on all legal options available to the City of Los Angeles, including any potential claims, defenses, and strategies to protect the City's interests, as expressed through Council file No. 26-0514 regarding a pathway forward on homelessness governance and short-term strategic actions; and, that the matter be scheduled for a Closed Session pursuant to applicable provisions of California Government Code Section 54956.9 to confer with legal counsel.
