MOTION

I MOVE that the Budget and Finance Committee report on the Mayor's Proposed Budget for 2026-27 be amended to instruct the City Administrative Officer, with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst and Community Investment Department, to report to the Economic Development and Jobs Committee on the feasibility and cost of adding one Management Analyst I to the Community Investment Department to oversee the City's work with the Garment and Fashion Industry. The position would: coordinate program development and services with WorkSource and BusinessSource Centers, in collaboration with the Garment Worker Center; support data collection and analysis on the industry to identify future policy needs; work with the Mayor's Office and Garment Worker Center to secure philanthropic funding to co-develop an upskilling program and pipeline to employment, including through worker ownership; and oversee the creation of a campaign and website that promotes ethical, local designers, manufacturers, and creative entrepreneurs and elevates the industry's history, services, and talent through the City's new channel websites, and social media platforms.
