

HOUSING & HOMELESSNESS

MOTION

In the 2026 / 27 Fiscal Year Budget approved by Council and signed by the Mayor, there is approved funding in the General City Purpose allocation to be administered by the City Clerk entitled: Citywide Recreational Vehicle (RV) to Home Program. The allocation provides funding to address RV homelessness, including outreach, service referral linkages, and interim housing resources specifically for this population.

The funding follows the RV to Home program in CF: 22-1324 (Motion: Rodriguez / Hutt, Price, Bonin) which ensures a uniformed response across the City on how the City can responsibly remove Recreational Vehicles from City streets while ensuring a path to housing for all participants.

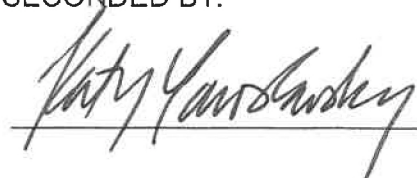
The RV to Home pilot program in Council District 7 has successfully moved 198 people to Permanent Supportive Housing, an additional 202 into interim housing for a total of 400 individuals helped, and we removed 192 RVs from the street.

I THEREFORE MOVE that Council directs the City Administrative Officer to report on how the funding allocated in the General City Purpose, line #19, will be allocated to Council Offices, for the expansion of the Recreational Vehicle (RV) to Home program.
