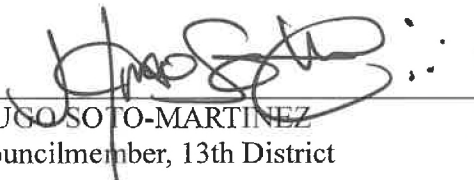
I MOVE that the Council Action of June 23, 2026, relative to EXEMPTIONS and CIVIL RIGHTS, EQUITY, IMMIGRATION, AGING, AND DISABILITY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the 52nd Program Year (PY) of the Housing and Community Development Consolidated Plan (2026-2027) (Action Plan), BE AMENDED to:

ADOPT the Contract Authority attached to this Motion for the General Manager of the Community Investment Department (CID), or designee, to extend existing contracts with the current operators of the Los Angeles Business Source Center System (LABSC) by six months to ensure continuity in services; and

REVISE the Contract Authorities (Attachment H) included in the Communication from the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), dated June 22, 2026, which allocate funds to various non-profit agencies and City departments that implement the PY 52 Consolidated Plan programs and activities, as follows:

- Delete Page 7 of the Contract Authorities included in the Communication from the CLA, which is a duplicate, and
- Replace the Page 7 with the Contract Authority attached to this Motion for CID to implement the LABSC, which was omitted in error.

Procurement:

A competitive RFP was conducted in 2026. Per CF 21-0270, EDD has been instructed to re-issue the 2026 LABSC RFP and to extend the existing LABSC contracts with the existing LABSC operators for six months to ensure continuity in services.

Program Description:

The Los Angeles BusinessSource Centers System is operated by community-based organizations with expertise and experience in providing technical assistance and centralized services to businesses. Training will target small businesses including sidewalk vendors and microenterprises. Direct technical assistance will lead to job creation/retention for LMI persons. Contractors will provide financial counseling, legal services, and digital presence and technology services to LABSCs and/or LABSC business clientele.
