

**RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT** relative to a ballot measure to enable the City Council to authorize noncitizen voting in elections for City offices and for members of the Los Angeles Board of Education.

SUBMITS WITHOUT RECOMMEDATION the following recommended action, pursuant to Motion (Soto-Martinez - Jurado):

REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present the documents necessary to place on the November 2026 ballot a measure that would amend the Charter to grant Council the ability to introduce an ordinance that would authorize noncitizens to vote in elections for City offices and for members of the Board of Education.
