

MOTION

Residents of El Sereno are proposing the development of a new park on several empty parcels of land that are currently under the jurisdiction of the Bureau of Engineering (BOE). These parcels were originally acquired by the BOE to stage materials for the Soto Street Bridge widening project, which has since been completed. The lot now sits empty attracting trash and other nuisances. In order to move forward with the park project, the parcels need to be transferred to the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP).

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council instruct the Bureau of Engineering to process a non-financial transfer of jurisdiction of the City-owned property located at 4285 Huntington Drive South, Los Angeles 90032, Assessor Parcel Numbers 5209-030-901, -902, and -900 from the Bureau of Engineering to the Department of Recreation and Parks, and to prepare and execute the Notice of Transfer of Jurisdiction and Control document to complete this transaction.


