Comments for Public Posting: Dear Councilman McOske, Illegal Dumping: I am writing to request your assistance with several issues that have continued unabated in my neighborhood and community for several years. I live in the Harbor Gateway District and have been a resident more than 25 years. (Figueroa and Alondra) Illegal dumping has increased substantially each week under the freeway located at Alondra and Estrella (Gardena)..The Department of Sanitation does an excellent job of removal when we report to 311. Our pickup day is each Monday, however after the street is cleaned by Sanitation, on the next day dumping re -occurs and we have to wait until the following week for pickup. May cameras or signage be installed at this location to help resolve this issue? there are license plate reader cameras I have heard about and if implemented or installed will help to catch offenders .I have several photos and will attempt to forward them at the end of this message Street Takeovers: Our neighborhood is being terrorized with Street Takeovers (Alondra & Figueroa) (Figueroa & 157th Street & Broadway) Large groups of people are gathering to watch these illegal spectacles, walking and parking in our community, running and creating a public nuisance. These incidents have increased substantially within the last six months, disrupting our safety and causing disturbances between the hours of 2:00 a.m. - 4:00 .a.m. We are requesting street calming measures, possible impoundment of vehicles, arrest of those participating in these spectacles. The Police Departments and Sheriff Departments always respond quickly and provide excellent service when we report these incidents, but they need additional help. There is a need for cameras to be placed in the areas affected along with monitoring which will determine when large groups are gathering after certain hours. Thank you for introducing this motion and we look forward to the implementation of safety measures to assist us.
