

MOTION

On June 4, 2024 the Council adopted Motion (Rodriguez - Krekorian; CF: 24-0488), which required that all all Commission appointees in the City of Los Angeles be required to file their financial disclosure statements, including a Form 700 (Statement of Economic Interests) and Form 60 (Restricted Source Financial Disclosure Statement) as a condition of their confirmation by the City Council, and require nominees to complete their governmental ethics training during the pre-confirmation process. Voters approved Charter Amendment HH (HH) in the November Election with 81.3% of voters casting a yes vote.


However, since the passage of HH Council has learned that not all commissions were captured in the intent of Council Actions. An example being the Charter Reform Commission, of which the Commissioners voluntarily submitted their forms prior to Council voting on their appointments.

It should be clarified that all appointees to Commission and Boards be required to submit Statement of Economic Interests and Restricted Source Financial Disclosure Statements prior to being voted on by Council, and in instances where no vote is required, appointees must submit these forms, prior to being seated.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Attorney be requested to prepare and present the documents necessary to place on the November 2026 ballot a measure that would amend the Charter to establish a requirement for all appointees to Commissions and Boards to submit the Statement of Economic Interests and Restricted Source Financial Disclosure Statements prior to being voted on by Council, and for instances where no vote is required, appointees must submit these forms prior to being seated.
