Decades of under-investment in the Bureau of Street Lighting (BSL) and a sharp increase in copper wire theft have led to prolonged delays in streetlight repairs, leaving neighborhoods across the city in the dark. To address public safety concerns from streetlight outages in the 4th Council District, BSL personnel must be allocated additional resources to complete their repair work.


I THEREFORE MOVE that the \$380,000 in the Council District 4 portion of the Council Projects line item in the General City Purposes Fund No. 100-56, Account No. 000A28 be transferred / appropriated to the below listed Accounts and in the amounts specified in the Street Lighting Fund No. 100-84 for street lighting repairs in Council District 4:
