

BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the improvement of audit and collection practices regarding Parking Occupancy Tax for non-compliant parking operators and landowners.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Hutt – Blumenfield):

1. INSTRUCT the Office of Finance, with the assistance from the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and the Department of Transportation (DOT), to report to Council on recommendations to improve audit and collection practices regarding Parking Occupancy Tax from non-compliant parking operators and landowners.
2. INSTRUCT the Office of Finance to include in its report summary information on current efforts to ensure the City is efficiently and equitably collecting all Parking Occupancy Tax revenue due to the City from all parking lot operators and landowners.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

At a Special meeting held on June 4, 2026, your Budget and Finance Committee considered Motion (Hutt - Blumenfield), dated May 1, 2026, relative to instructing the Office of Finance, with the assistance from the CAO and the DOT, to report on recommendations for the improvement of audit and collection practices regarding Parking Occupancy Tax from non-compliant parking operators and landowners, including current efforts to ensure the City is efficiently and equitably collecting all Parking Occupancy Tax revenue due by all parking lot operators and landowners. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
