This donation will provide funding to Training Division for improvements to the interior lobby and first-floor hallways of the Ahmanson Recruit Training Center (ARTC). NAME OF REQUEST: Ahmanson Recruit Training Center Lobby Improvement Project

It is requested that Training Division be approved for a donation for improvements to the interior lobby and first-floor hallways of the Ahmanson Recruit Training Center (ARTC) from the Los Angeles Police Foundation (LAPF), valued at \$146,661.00. The proposed upgrades include a repainting of the entire first-floor hallways and upgrading the lighting in the lobby and hallways. Approval of this donation benefits the Department as follows:

In the mid-1990s, the ARTC was established for the training of Los Angeles Police Department recruit officers. Over the past 30 years the ARTC has been the primary facility for recruits but has not been renovated since it was established and is beginning to look outdated. The ARTC requires the above updates to address aging infrastructure, including faulty lighting, deteriorating paint, and to maintain a professional and functional training environment. Below is a breakdown of the total cost for the project:
