

CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION and TRADE, TRAVEL, AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT relative to Port of Los Angeles (POLA) Resolution No. 26-10702 approving Permit No. 970 with Taylored Transload, LLC and Waterfront Logistics.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. CONCUR that the determination by the Board of Harbor Commissioners (BOHC) that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Article III, Class 1(14) and 1(18)(d) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
2. APPROVE POLA Resolution No. 26-10702 related to Permit No. 970 with Taylored Transload, LLC and Waterfront Logistics.
3. AUTHORIZE the POLA Executive Director, or designee, to execute said permit with Taylored Transload LLC and Waterfront Logistics.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The BOHC reports that there is no impact to the General Fund. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
