

CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION and TRADE, TRAVEL AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT relative to Port of Los Angeles (POLA) Resolution No. 26-10712 approving Permit No. 967 with So. Cal. Ship Services, LLC.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. CONCUR that the determination by the Board of Harbor Commissioners (BOHC) that the proposed action is categorically exempt and has been previously evaluated pursuant to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Article III, Class 1(3) and Article II, Section 2(i) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
2. APPROVE POLA Resolution No. 26-10712 for Permit No. 967 with So. Cal. Ship Services, LLC.
3. AUTHORIZE the POLA Executive Director, or designee, to execute said permit with So. Cal. Ship Services, LLC.
