

In 2022, the Encino Avenue Pedestrian Overcrossing on US Route 101 was demolished to correct nonstandard vertical clearance, and the structure was not replaced. With the permanent removal of the structure, improvements to bicycle and pedestrian facilities were warranted to provide alternate paths of travel and \$2,300,000 was appropriated through the California State Budget Act of 2021 for that purpose. The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) encumbered \$521,000 of the \$2,300,000 for sidewalk and curb ramp construction on the south side of Killion Street as well as fencing. The construction of the Caltrans scope has been completed, and the remaining \$1,779,000 of the funding appropriation can now be used by the City to implement additional improvements.

The manner of transfer of funds will be a Funding Transfer Agreement (FTA) between the City of Los Angeles' Bureau of Street Services and Caltrans. Similar to other such agreements, once executed, the funds will be received by the City of Los Angeles as an advanced lump sum.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council **AUTHORIZE** the Bureau of Street Services to accept the allocation of a portion of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) funds in the total of \$1,779,000 appropriated under Section 19.57(e)(4)(A) of the Budget Act of 2021, and execute the Funds Transfer Agreement (FTA) with Caltrans for the purposes outlined in Section 3.1 of the FTA: to implement street safety and active transportation improvements within and around the location of the removed Encino Avenue Pedestrian Overcrossing on U.S. Route 101 in the City of Los Angeles (Project). The improvements will be located between White Oak Avenue, Oxnard Street, Balboa Boulevard, and Ventura Boulevard. The Project scope will include bicycle and pedestrian improvements such as protected bike lanes, sidewalks, fencing, and landscaping.
