Comments for Public Posting: I oppose Councilmember Jurado's resolution in Council File 26-0777 and I urge all Councilmembers to vote no on it. I've been walking the Arroyo Seco path for over thirty years, and I know these sites as well as anyone. The San Pascual area is overgrown with invasive species and dry brush, and I've personally documented burned trees, fire rings, and serious trash. This project would replace that with a native landscape — oaks, sycamores, willows — that actually supports wildlife and cleans polluted runoff before it reaches the river. Yes, some trees would come out, but the replanting brings a net gain in natives. That trade is worth making.
