

PUBLIC SAFETY AND BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEES REPORT relative to the acceptance of the 2026 Regional Hazardous Materials Response Training Agreement No. A261016460.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the Fire Chief, or designee, to:
 - a. Accept the 2026 Regional Hazardous Materials Response (RHMR) agreement in the amount of \$100,000, and any increases during the performance period, from the acceptance date through June 30, 2029, as granted by the Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES), and to execute any documents or agreements necessary to accept the grant on the City's behalf.
 - b. Expend funds in an amount up to \$100,000 from Fund 100, Department 38, Account 001098 Variable Staffing Overtime; Account 002130 Travel; and Account 006010 Office and Administrative for all training and travel expenses incurred in accordance with the RHMR agreement terms from Cal OES.
2. AUTHORIZE the Controller to deposit reimbursement grant funds up to \$100,000, and any additional increases and administrative fees from Cal OES into Fund 335, Department 38, Account to be determined.
3. AUTHORIZE the Fire Department to:
 - a. Transfer reimbursement grant funds from Fund 335, Department 38, Account TBD to Fund 100, Department 38, Account 001098 (Variable Staffing); Account 002130 (Travel); Account 006010 (Office and Administrative); Account 006020 (Operating Supplies); and Fund 100, Department 38, Revenue Source Code 005301 (Reimbursement from Other Funds) upon submission of proper documentation by the Los Angeles Fire Department of actual costs incurred from the eligible Hazardous Materials Training Courses, subject to the review and approval of the City Administrative Officer.
 - b. Prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer, and AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer reports that approval of the recommendations in this report will allow for the acceptance of the Regional Hazardous Materials Response Standard Agreement in the amount of up to \$100,000 from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services for a three-year term commencing upon approval through June 2029. Acceptance of the Agreement will require the Los Angeles Fire Department to front-fund expenditures of up to \$100,000. There is no additional fiscal impact to the Los Angeles Fire Department departmental budget. The Governor's Office of Emergency Services will reimburse the Los Angeles Fire Department a total amount of up to \$100,000 and may increase the program budget on an annual basis at a rate to be determined by the Governor's Office of Emergency Services.

Financial Policies Statement: The City Administrative Officer reports that the recommendations within this report comply with the City's Financial Policies in that all grant funds will be utilized to fund grant activities.

SUMMARY

At the regular meeting held on August 12, 2026, your Public Safety Committee considered Board of Fire Commissioners and City Administrative Officer reports relative to the acceptance of the 2026 Regional Hazardous Materials Response Training Agreement No. A261016460.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended approval of the City Administrative Officer recommendations, as detailed above.

Subsequently, on August 18, 2026, your Budget and Finance Committee considered the same item and, after providing an opportunity for public comment, moved to concur with the action previously taken by the Public Safety Committee.

This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
