

ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Measure W Safe, Clean Water Program Regional Program Transfer Agreement with the Los Angeles County Flood Control District for the annual receipt of Measure W Funds for the Street Sweeping Study Round 6 Project.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the President, Board of Public Works (BPW), or two members, and the Director, Bureau of Sanitation (BOS), or designee, to execute a Transfer Agreement for the Street Sweeping Study in the Upper Los Angeles River (ULAR) watershed, referred to as Safe, Clean Water Round 6 (2025-26) Regional Project, between the BOS and the Los Angeles County Flood Control District, which has been approved by the BPW; and, as consistent with the Los Angeles Administrative Code, delegate authority to the Director of the BOS to negotiate and execute Addenda materially consistent with the transfer agreement, subject to the City Attorney approval as to form, through completion of the Project.
2. AUTHORIZE the Controller to record \$688,350 in receivables from the Los Angeles County Flood Control District in the Measure W – Safe, Clean Water – Regional Projects Special Fund No. 63F/50, Department Revenue Source No. 318423, Street Sweeping Study ULAR, establish a new account to be determined, and appropriate funds.
3. AUTHORIZE the City Administrative Officer (CAO) to make technical changes as needed to implement the Mayor and Council intentions.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that there is no impact to the General Fund as the funding for this Project will be provided by the Safe, Clean Water Regional Program. The 2025-26 revenues totaling \$688,350 will be deposited into the Fund No. 63F, Measure W – Safe, Clean Water – Regional Projects, Departmental Revenue Source No. 318423 (Street Sweeping Scientific Study ULAR).

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the recommendations above are in compliance with the City’s Financial Policies in that expenditures are limited to the mandates of the funding source, and that one-time revenues will support one-time costs.
