**Comments for Public Posting:** Dear City Council members. I'm speaking in my personal capacity. I want to thank you for the focus on resources and real support for a community still feeling the impacts of this devastation. Community advocates—including the Boyle Heights Neighborhood Council—have been calling for accountability from the operators of Lineage Logistics and urging them to do more for their neighbors. Some Neighborhood Councils have already dedicated funding to help residents, and we thank them. We will continue standing together—supporting our neighbors and demanding meaningful accountability from those responsible. Many in our community have also called for Lineage Logistics to shut down and not be allowed to operate within a residential neighborhood. The City of Los Angeles should not allow Lineage Logistics to operate in a residential neighborhood. This has caused significant harm to our community.
