

ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the results of water quality testing conducted on stormwater runoff associated with the Boyle Heights Lineage warehouse fire, as well as the status of the Cleanup and Abatement Order.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Jurado – Nazarian):

1. INSTRUCT the Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) to report on the final results of water quality testing conducted on stormwater runoff associated with the June 17, 2026, Boyle Heights Lineage warehouse fire, including any findings regarding contaminants detected, impacts to receiving waters, and any recommendations for ongoing monitoring.
2. INSTRUCT the BOS to report on the status of the requested Cleanup and Abatement Order issued by the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board, including any approved remediation plan, implementation timeline, responsible agencies, and progress made toward protecting public health and water quality.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on August 18, 2026, your Energy and Environment Committee considered a Motion (Jurado – Nazarian) relative to results of water quality testing conducted on stormwater runoff associated with the Boyle Heights Lineage warehouse fire, as well as the status of the Cleanup and Abatement Order.
