MOTION

Laurel Canyon Boulevard in Sun Valley runs parallel to the Golden State (Interstate 5) Freeway, absorbing I-5 ramp volumes and diversion traffic that produce speeds incompatible with a corridor serving two affordable senior housing developments, the Sun Valley WorkSource Center, and other pedestrian-generating uses, all without a signalized crossing. When the McDonald's at 9009 Laurel Canyon Boulevard was constructed, community members raised the need for safety improvements to the Sun Valley Area Neighborhood Council. McDonald's has agreed to contribute \$100,000 toward installation of a future Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon (PHB/HAWK signal) near Laurel Canyon Boulevard and Jerome Street, an improvement that fulfills the Los Angeles Department of Transportation recommendation for enhanced pedestrian crosswalk under LADOT Case Nos. SFV23-55385, dated September 5th, 2024. Action is needed to accept this contribution and cause it to be deposited in the Council District 6 Public Benefits Trust Fund Trust Fund No. 50C-14.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council accept a \$100,000 contribution from McDonald's for the installation of a PHB at Laurel Canyon Boulevard and Jerome Street, on behalf of the City, and cause this sum to be deposited into the Council District 6 Public Benefits Trust Fund No 50C-14; and

I FURTHER MOVE that the Councilmember of the 6th District be authorized to sign any agreements associated with the McDonald's contribution, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality; and

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be authorized to make any corrections, clarifications, or revisions to the above fund transfer instructions, including any new instructions, in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion; and
