The CIS process was enable by the to Los Angeles Administrative Code §Section 22.819. It provides that, "a Neighborhood Council may take a formal position on a matter by way of a Community Impact Statement (CIS) or written resolution." NCs representatives also testify before City Boards and Commissions on the item related to their CIS. If the Neighborhood Council chooses to do so, the Neighborhood Council representative must provide the Commission with a copy of the CIS or rResolution sufficiently in advance for review, possible inclusion on the agenda, and posting on the Commission's website.Any information you can provide related to your agenda setting schedule is helpful to share with the NC.

If the CIS or resolution pertains to a matter *listed on the Commission's agenda*, during the time the matter is heard, the designated Neighborhood Council representative should be given an opportunity to present the Neighborhood Council's formal position. We encourage becoming familiar with the City Councils rules on the subject. At the Chair's discretion, the Neighborhood Council representative may be asked to have a seat at the table (or equivalent for a virtual meeting) typically reserved for City staff and may provide the Neighborhood Council representative more time than allotted to members of the general public. They are also permitted up to five (5) minutes of time to address the legislative body. If the CIS or resolution pertains to a matter *not listed on the agenda*, the designated Neighborhood Council representative may speak during General Public Comments.

Summary: The Venice Neighborhood Council has adopted Motion 103-26-VNC which reads as follows: The Venice Neighborhood Council supports the motion in Council File 26-0956 to instruct various City departments to: 1) report back on the feasibility of conditioning city funding for permanent supportive projects on the provision of background checks and comprehensive behavioral-health and risk assessments, in addition to screening out individuals with violent criminal histories; 2) report with recommendations to update the City's Model Property Management Policies and Procedures to account for safety within and outside publicly funded housing projects; 3) prepare recommendations for strengthened "Good Neighbor" operational agreements for City-funded housing, including but not limited to required on-site security

staffing levels, 24/7 staffing requirements for higher-acuity sites, security cameras in common areas and entrances, controlled access systems, and regular security audits; 4) report on intake and assessment protocols for supportive housing projects, including whether providers are conducting comprehensive behavioral-health and risk assessments, screening for violent criminal histories, evaluating severe mental illness and substance use needs, and matching residents with appropriate levels of care rather than placing high-acuity individuals in lower-support settings; 5) report with recommendations for “higher-acuity placement pathways,” for individuals with repeated violent conduct, serious untreated mental illness, or persistent behavioral crises, including coordination with County behavioral health programs; and 6) report on the feasibility of creating a dispute resolution process to mediate concerns between neighbors and permanent supportive housing operators.
