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Comments for Public Posting: I am alarmed by the LAPD's decision to "ghost" the CAO regarding a potential charter reform that would provide the City Council with oversight. For too long, the LAPD has effectively held the City hostage, limiting the Council's ability to hold the Department accountable for misconduct and civil-rights violations. Meanwhile, the City's liability costs continue to rise. I urge the City Council and the CAO to take a clear, harder stance: the LAPD does not own the City—it is accountable to the public it serves. The City must use its lawful authority to ensure transparency, enforce accountability, and end obstruction of justice.
