

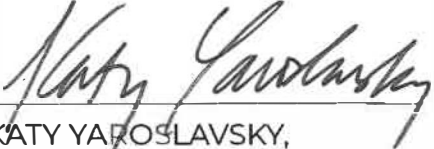
AMENDING MOTION

I MOVE that Item 13 on today's Council Agenda, Council File 26-1050, *ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to modernizing the City's internal Tree Spacing Guidelines*, be AMENDED to add the following Instructions

- INSTRUCT the Bureau of Street Services, in coordination with the Bureau of Engineering, Bureau of Street Lighting, Department of Water and Power, Department of Transportation, Department of City Planning, and any other relevant departments, to incorporate into the 90-day report all outstanding Council instructions adopted under Council File 24-1228, including:
 - A review of state and City laws, policies, standards, and procedures that limit the size, location, and species of trees planted in the public right-of-way, identifying which restrictions are required by state or federal law and which are established by City policy.
 - Recommendations for tree planting and spacing modifications, design solutions to protect underground infrastructure, and pruning standards that would allow for more and larger trees in the public right-of-way.
 - Recommendations to update relevant street and tree-well standards, including applicable Bureau of Engineering standard plans, to increase tree-well size and available growing space where feasible, particularly on streets with wider sidewalks.

The report should include specific proposed revisions to applicable City standards, guidelines, and specifications needed to implement these recommendations.
