
- REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present the documents necessary for the November 2026 Ballot to amend Charter Section 245 related to City Council Veto of Board Actions, as follows (as indicated in strikethrough, bold, and underline):

Actions of boards of commissioners shall become final at the expiration of the next ~~five-meeting~~ **15 calendar** days of the Council during which the Council has convened in regular session, unless the Council acts within that time by two-thirds vote to bring the action before it or to waive review of the action, except that as to any action of the Board of Police Commissioners regarding the removal of the Chief of Police, the time period within which the Council may act before the action of the Board shall become final shall be ~~ten-meeting~~ **twenty-one calendar** days during which the Council has convened in regular session.
