I MOVE that the matter of the COMMUNICATION FROM THE CITY ATTORNEY, ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION, and BALLOT RESOLUTION relative to a ballot measure regarding a charter amendment related to the Ethics, Elections, and Governance, Item No. 93 on today's Council Agenda (CF 26-1100-S13), BE AMENDED to adopt the following recommendation:

REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present the documents necessary for the November 2026 Ballot to amend Charter Section 242(a) related to Conduct of Business as follows:

(a) The Council shall hold regular ^{AT LEAST WEEKLY} ~~weekly~~ meetings ~~at least three days each week~~. Meetings may be held in City Hall or elsewhere in the City. By resolution, the Council may establish periods during which the Council or its committees will be in recess. The Council and its committees may also each hold special meetings with proper notice.
