Honorable Members:

On June 26, 2026, this Office transmitted the ballot resolutions and election ordinances necessary to place several Charter amendment measures on the November ballot. We have discovered unnecessary language in the ballot question of the measure related to ethics, elections, and governance matters. The ballot question inadvertently made a reference to a Charter change regarding campaign finance rules for LAUSD Board of Education elections, but that change is embodied in a different Charter amendment measure in Council File No. 26-1100-S19. We have removed this language from the corrected draft. In addition, by removing the LAUSD election language, there was additional space in the ballot question to further describe the proposed changes to the requirements for referendum petitions. We are now transmitting the corrected ballot resolution and election ordinance, approved as to form and legality.
