

MOTION

I MOVE that the matter of the COMMUNICATION FROM THE CITY ATTORNEY, ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION, and BALLOT RESOLUTION relative to a ballot measure regarding a charter amendment related to the proprietary departments in the City of Los Angeles, Item No. 96 on today's Council Agenda (CF 26-1100-S16), BE AMENDED to adopt the following recommendation:

REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present the documents necessary for the November 2026 Ballot to amend the Charter to require a workforce impact disclosure in connection with certain development actions at the Port of Los Angeles, as follows:

The Board of Harbor Commissioners shall require, as a condition of approval for any lease, lease extension, or amendment, or proposed development of Harbor Department property requiring a Coastal Development Permit, a workforce impact disclosure. The disclosure should include an assessment of estimated workforce effects, including but not limited to the potential impact on employment associated with the premises and the estimated economic impact on the region to the extent known. The Harbor Department policy may exempt small businesses and nonprofit corporations, as defined by the Board, from providing an economic impact analysis. The Board of Harbor Commissioners shall consider disclosures submitted by an applicant under this subsection consistent with the Board's fiduciary duties under California Public Resources Code sections 6005, 6009.1, and 6306 and other applicable law.
