

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a Special Election was ordered to be held in the City of Los Angeles pursuant to Ordinance No. 188872 to place a measure before the voters and the election was consolidated with the City of Los Angeles Primary Nominating Election; and

WHEREAS, the following measure was submitted to a vote of the qualified voters of the City of Los Angeles:

FUNDING FOR CITY SERVICES THROUGH MODIFICATIONS TO THE TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX. PROPOSITION TT.

Shall an ordinance be adopted to fund general City services, such as street/sidewalk repairs, 911 emergency response, fire protection, and parks, by: increasing the transient occupancy tax, currently 14% paid by hotel and lodging guests, to 16% through 2028 and then 15% thereafter; and requiring online and other travel companies to collect and remit the tax; generating approximately \$22-44 million annually until ended by voters?

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk did canvass the returns of the Primary Nominating Election held in the City of Los Angeles on June 2, 2026, and certified them to the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Los Angeles City Council that the canvass of votes is true and correct.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Los Angeles City Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that the total number of votes cast for and against City of Los Angeles Proposition TC at the Primary Nominating Election by the qualified voters was 553,726 as set forth in the certification of the Los Angeles City Clerk, and that the measure, as proposed by Resolution of the Los Angeles City Council, is hereby declared to have been rejected by a majority of the voters voting thereon.
