I MOVE that the matter of the COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE CITY CLERK, THE CITY ATTORNEY and THE CITY ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER, CERTIFICATE OF SUFFICIENCY OF INITIATIVE PETITION, RESOLUTION, and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to an Initiative Petition regarding the Repeal of Los Angeles City Business Gross Receipts Tax on Virtually All Businesses Operating in the City, Item No. 19 (CF: 23-1100-S7) on today's Council agenda, BE AMENDED to:

1. Adopt Recommendation B.2, relative to the adoption of the accompanying ELECTION ORDINANCE and BALLOT RESOLUTION to submit the proposed initiative ordinance, without alteration, to a vote of the electors of the City at the next regular City and Statewide election conducted by the County of Los Angeles to be held more than 110 days from the date of Council action (the City's General Municipal Election held on November 3, 2026);
2. Amend the ballot question to state that the estimated annual decrease in tax revenues is 'approximately \$860M'; and
3. Adopt Recommendation C, relative to the recommendations from the CAO's report, dated May 6, 2026.
