

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to installing "No Idling" signs and other traffic control measures in the Harbor Gateway South community.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (McOsker – Hutt):

DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to report with recommendations to address truck activity and idling issues in the Harbor Gateway South community, including the installation of "No Idling" signs and other traffic control measures that would improve safety and reduce the impacts of these large commercial vehicles in the area.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On September 16, 2026, your Committee considered a Motion (McOsker – Hutt) relative to installing "No Idling" signs and other traffic control measures in the Harbor Gateway South community. According to the Motion, the Harbor Gateway South community is experiencing ongoing issues regarding truck activity and idling at several locations, specifically on Denker Avenue between Torrance Boulevard and Del Amo Boulevard and Western Avenue between Del Amo Boulevard and Francisco Street. Additionally, there has been a significant increase in truck traffic on Denker Avenue between 209th Street and Del Amo Boulevard. Such conditions raise public safety concerns for residents, in addition to exacerbating traffic in these areas. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approving the Motion. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
