

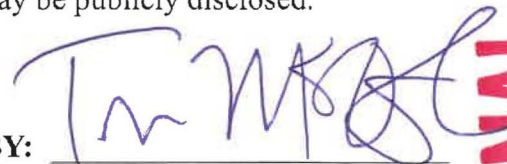
MOTION

JCI Jones Chemicals, Inc. (JCI) operates an industrial facility in Harbor Gateway that has been the subject of ongoing City review and enforcement related to public safety and regulatory compliance (Council Files 25-1469 and 26-0794). The City Council previously directed City departments to evaluate options concerning the facility. JCI has reportedly presented a feasibility study regarding options for the site. That feasibility study may inform the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD), Department of City Planning (DCP), Department of Building and Safety (LADBS), and other agencies on next steps, including a proposed "consent order". The Council should have access to the feasibility study and ensure that any consent order currently being developed preserves the City's full regulatory and enforcement authority.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council request the City Attorney, in coordination with the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD), Department of City Planning (DCP), and Department of Building and Safety (LADBS), to obtain and provide to Council District 15 the feasibility study for the JCI Jones Chemicals, Inc. (JCI) Harbor Gateway facility, and provide an assessment of whether and to what extent the study may be publicly disclosed.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Council request the City Attorney, in coordination with the LAFD, DCP, and LADBS, to obtain and provide to Council District 15 any proposed consent order concerning the JCI Harbor Gateway facility, prior to adoption, and provide an assessment of whether and to what extent the consent order may be publicly disclosed.

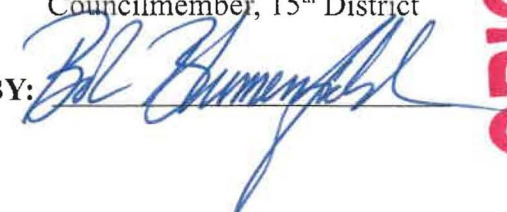
