On behalf of the four Department traffic divisions, it is requested that South Traffic Division (STD) be approved for grant funds to procure two Bosch Event Data Recorders and supporting hardware systems. The items are collectively valued at \$80,569.00. Approval of this donation benefits the Department as follows:

Traffic detectives use a variety of technologies to investigate fatal and severe traffic crashes. One of the most valuable technology tools is the Bosch Event Data Recorder. This device is used to extract information from the internal computer system(s) of a vehicle and provides detectives with valuable information that will be used in filing cases. Quite often, court filing decisions are dependent on the information revealed by these devices.

A secondary benefit for traffic detectives will be the cost-savings posed by the expedited data retrieval these systems provide. Typically, it takes weeks to request data via external resources; however, with the system readily available to detectives, the vehicle impound holds can be dramatically reduced.

South Traffic Division proposes that Central and South Traffic Divisions share the use of one system, while West and Valley Traffic Divisions share the use of the second system.
