

MOTION

The City currently has underutilized center medians along Broadway between 93rd Street and 112th Street that could be used as green space for the surrounding neighborhoods along this street segment. These stretches of green space could be improved with benches, workout equipment, and a walking path to make these medians accessible as usable space for residents.

As medians are currently maintained by the Bureau of Street Services and the Department of Recreation and Parks has experience developing and maintaining recreational spaces, these agencies should coordinate and report back with recommendations to convert the Broadway center medians into functional parklets for the enjoyment of the surrounding communities, including recommendations on what recreational improvements are feasible at this site and what agreements are necessary to allow the Department of Recreation and Parks to maintain recreational improvements here.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Bureau of Street Services, with the assistance of the Bureau of Engineering and any other necessary departments, be instructed and the Department of Recreation and Parks be requested to report with recommendations to develop the center medians along Broadway between 93rd Street and 112th Street as green and recreational spaces with benches, workout equipment, and a walking path to be managed and maintained by the Department of Recreation and Parks.

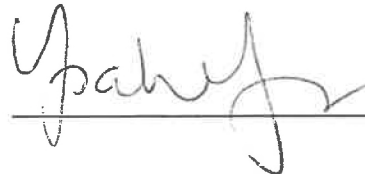
