

MOTION

The City of Los Angeles is lucky to benefit from its diverse and vibrant religious communities. One of the most important tasks the City has is to be a good steward for these groups. This includes ensuring all Angelenos can practice their religion peacefully, safely and without unnecessary barriers.

During the Jewish High Holidays, the City's Department of Transportation (DOT), Parking Enforcement and Traffic Control Division relaxes parking enforcement of street cleaning, time limit and preferential parking restrictions to accommodate Jewish Angelenos as they make their way to synagogue during these important holidays. Historically, there is a list of streets that are included around Jewish houses of worship. However currently there is no formal and permanent process for adding new streets as new synagogues are started or communities expand and congregations grow. Council Districts are requested to, on an ad-hoc basis, add the streets to a database which does not carry over year to year. DOT has explained that there are cost barriers preventing them from adding streets to the relaxed parking enforcement list.

The lack of a standardized process creates confusion in the community and for City staff which can result in inconsistent enforcement. Establishing a clear process would provide greater certainty.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council DIRECT the Department of Transportation (DOT), Parking Enforcement and Traffic Control Division to add the following street segments to the list for this year, and every subsequent year, relaxed enforcement:

- Lindley Avenue and Etiwanda Avenue between Burbank Boulevard and Oxnard and all the streets in between (which includes Miranda, Chimineas, Bromley, Hatteras, Califa and Emelita) in Council District 3.
- The 15700 block of Morrison Street (between Densmore Avenue and Haskell Avenue); the 4700-4900 block of Haskell Avenue (between Addison Street and Ventura Boulevard); the 5200-5300 block of Leghorn Ave (from Magnolia to Chandler); and the 5200 and 5300 block of Coldwater Canyon Ave (from Magnolia to Chandler) in Council District 4.

I FURTHER MOVE that DOT report back with a formal process on adding new street segments that require relaxed parking enforcement to this list and any costs associated with the codification of the process.

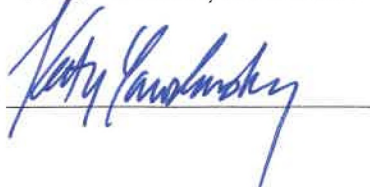
