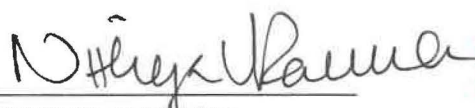
Located on Hyperion Avenue in Silver Lake, Casita Del Campo is a local, family owned restaurant and community landmark. The all pink restaurant was opened in 1962 by Rudy Del Campo, a Broadway dancer featured in *West Side Story*. After leaving the entertainment industry, Rudy dedicated himself to creating a community oriented space with fine Mexican food, loyal clientele, and friendly service. Over 64 years later, the Del Campo family have continued Rudy's dedication to the spirit of family, connection, celebration, and community within their restaurant's walls.

Casita Del Campo has long been an important, inclusive gathering place for artists, immigrants, musicians, actors, and families throughout Silver Lake and broader Los Angeles. Founded during a time when many spaces were not safe for the LGBTQ+ Community, the restaurant opened its doors to all, becoming known in the community as a haven for expression, performance, acceptance, and joy. The iconic Cavern Club Cabaret at Casita Del Campo continues on this tradition and is a treasured theatrical venue for local artists and everything from Latin Jazz, to Comedy, to Cabaret and Drag shows.

With delicious food and drinks, Casita Del Campo is a destination beloved by locals and visitors alike. Furthermore, the Del Campo Family's remarkable work and dedication to this iconic restaurant exemplifies the best of what Los Angeles has to offer.
