Comments for Public Posting: I urge the City Council in the strongest terms to oppose Council File 26-4118-S7, a resolution designating seven locations in Council District 11 as LAMC 41.18(c)(4) enforcement zones, scheduled for a vote on August 4. This resolution does not comply with the plain text of the ordinance it invokes, and adopting it as written would exceed the Council's authority under its own Municipal Code. Those of us on the ground in Council District 11, like me (I have been a homeowner here 17 years), can see that Councilmember Park has designated large areas as no sitting/sleeping citing a public safety rationale but with no perceptible public safety justification. She is attempting to do it again, flouting the intention of the law.
