

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, §41.18 of the Municipal Code provides that the Council by Resolution may designate specified areas for enforcement against sitting, lying, sleeping, or storing, using, maintaining, or placing personal property, or otherwise obstructing the public right-of-way, in order for a person to be found in violation of any of these prohibited behaviors; and

WHEREAS, the below listed locations are experiencing a need for enforcement against the above listed prohibitions; and

WHEREAS, the Council hereby finds that the public health, safety, or welfare is served by the prohibition, and further finds that sleeping or lodging within the stated proximity to the designated area(s) is unhealthy, unsafe, or incompatible with safe passage; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Council District 11 has submitted / posted to the File relevant documentation, as further detailed in the Code, that the circumstances at this location poses a particular and ongoing threat to public health or safety;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to §41.18 (c)(4) of the Los Angeles Municipal Code that the Council hereby designates the following location for enforcement against sitting, lying, sleeping, or storing, using, maintaining, or placing personal property, or otherwise obstructing the public right-of-way, up to the maximum distance and effective for the maximum period of time prescribed, and as further detailed in the Code;

2. 8651 S La Tijera Blvd, Los Angeles, CA 90045 – Public Safety
3. 8921 S Sepulveda Blvd, Los Angeles, CA 90045 – Public Safety
4. 604 Rose Ave, Venice, CA 90291 – Public Safety
5. 204 Hampton Dr, Venice, CA 90291 – Public Safety
6. 720 Rose Ave, Venice, CA 90291 – Public Safety
7. 12054 Wilshire Blvd, Los Angeles, CA 90025 – Public Safety

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Department(s) with jurisdiction over the identified locations are hereby directed and authorized to post appropriate notices of the above prohibitions at this location, and to begin enforcement upon the expiration of any required posting period.
